Paul was an apostle or messenger of the teachings of Jesus all around the Mediterranean Sea. He visited many places including Corinth at least three times. He stayed in Corinth and wrote letters to different people and places from Corinth. He also wrote several letters to the people in Corinth who were called Corinthians. Paul must have known Corinth quite well!

In one of the letters that Paul wrote to the Corinthians there is a part that is very well known It is in 1 Corinthians chapter 13. In it Paul explains how important love is, what God's meaning of love is and how you should behave towards others.

Paul is saying that the kind of words you use - everyday words you use all the time - tell people all sorts of things but the important part is remembering to use those words with love. You need to think before you speak so you can put into action God's special love.

You need to get your tongue ready for action. A tongue is a group of strong muscles and needs exercise, so stretch it out as far as it will go without making any noise. Now wag it from side to side while saying lah, lah, lah.

Put your tongue back in your mouth and hold your nose and breathe through your mouth. Can you feel the cool air rushing over the back of your tongue?

Put the tip of your tongue behind your bottom teeth. Make your lips into a small 'o' shape. Blow out. Can you hear a whistling sound? If it is difficult to whistle, over your tongue up or down a bit and try again. You can also change your lips a bit to see if that helps.
