Reading read by Moira Holmes Luke 11:1-13

11 He was praying in a certain place, and after he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.' 2 He said to them, 'When you pray, say:

Father, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

- 3 Give us each day our daily bread.
- 4 And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone indebted to us. And do not bring us to the time of trial.'
